The town is located 26 miles northwest of London. The high street is on a pre roman route to London with lots of interesting architectural styles, our own office sits in a building well over 200 years old. Berkhamsted dates back to about to 1000 AD and was mentioned in the doomsday book of 1086 and has its own Castle, sadly just ruins now as it was abandoned in 1495, it now belongs to the Dutchy of Cornwall and is looked after by English Heritage – the site is often used for events. Just off the High Street is the Grand Union Canal and the Train Station which offers a frequent service in under 30 minutes to London Euston. The Town Centre has a range of independent and boutique retailers as well as national retailers such as Marks & Spencers and Waitrose.

Berkhamsted is home to some of the best schools in the area, the Berkhamsted School is an independent day and boarding school dating back to 1541 with famous alumni such as Clementine Churchill, Will Fraser and more recently Roman Kemp.
